



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

Annotations (20%)	identifying key points, links within text, links with other works on the topic



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Summary and reference (30%)	relevance of summary to assignment question, paraphrasing, complexity and accuracy of language, use of selected words, referencing style, word limit



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Vocabulary (20%)	number of words selected, relevance of words to topic, accuracy of records, recording method



Disadvantages

- The task is a product portfolio assesses the results of learning; no insight into the learning process.
- Students have no opportunity to select their best work they need to submit the required pieces.
- Teaching to the assessment teaching may focus only on the skills required to complete the tasks.
- Independent learning is not fully supported self-assessment is not part of the process.
- Marking is complex, time consuming and involves the use of subjective evaluation procedures.

Advantages

- Strengthens self-direction and contributes to developing learner independence.
- Tasks act as tools for the learning process.
- Allows students to reflect on their learning methods.
- Product demonstrates mastery of a set of learning objectives.
- Enables measurement of multiple dimensions of mastery.

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
